### **Chicago Police Arrest Man and Seize Bulk Quantity of Cocaine with a Street Value of \$50,000**

*Ohio Man Charged After Vehicle Stop Leads to Narcotics*

CHICAGO – Oscar Davis, 28, of Cincinnati, Ohio, was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance-Manufacturing/Delivery, Possession Misdemeanor Cannabis and one citation for Overtaking Vehicle on Right.

On March 9, 2010 at approximately 9:50 p.m., tactical officers from the Austin (15<sup>th</sup>) District were on patrol, when they observed Davis driving a Lincoln town car traveling southbound on Austin Blvd near Madison. The officers pulled Davis over after they observed him overtake a vehicle on the right. The officers approached the vehicle and smelled a strong odor of cannabis, at which time Davis told the officers he had a couple of bags of cannabis in his pockets.

The alert officers continued to smell a strong odor of cannabis emanating from the vehicle. The officers then contacted the Chicago Police Canine Unit and with their help located (4) four bricks of cocaine hidden inside the drivers rear door. Davis was placed into custody and charged accordingly.

Due to the officer's efforts and keen observation and attention to detail, they were able to locate and remove the cocaine before it made its way to our city streets.

Davis was scheduled to appear in bond court on March 10, 2010.
