USE CAUTION

It is very important to keep in mind that the crooks who want to get inside your home may have access to similar uniforms and fake identification cards as city, county, federal or state employees. If the individual is unknown to you, **DO NOT ALLOW ENTRY** into your residence.

IMPORTANT SAFETY TIPS:

- Keep your doors locked at all times. Use deadbolt locks on exterior doors. (Install a peep-hole in the door and use it).
- Never allow strangers to enter your residence.
- Request identification cards from the unknown person.
- Never accept an unsolicited “free” inspection of your furnace, roof, air conditioner or anything else in your home.
- Call the company the person claims he/she works for to verify employment.
- **Get to know your neighbors** and keep their telephone numbers in **case of emergencies**. Use the “buddy” system to check on each other.
- Call **911** for any Suspicious Criminal Activity.
