### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 48-Year-Old Male, Armed Robbery of 42-Year-Old Male and 67-Year-Old Female



**Offender:** Demontre Enos, 30  
3500 block of W. Lexington St.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
Two (2) felony counts – Robbery - Armed with Firearm

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 1, 2026

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on March 31, 2026, in the 3100 block of W. Flournoy St. He was identified as the offender who, on January 20, 2026, shot and seriously injured a 48-year-old male victim in the 600 block of S. Independence Blvd. (11<sup>th</sup> District). The offender also took personal property at gunpoint from a 42-year-old male victim and a 67-year-old female victim in the same incident. The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
