Preliminary Statement on Police-Involved Shooting in the 1800 block of S. Central Park Ave.

CHICAGO – On Sunday, February 2, 2025, at approximately 10:47 a.m., uniformed Chicago Police Officers assigned to the 10th (Ogden) District responded to a burglary-in-progress call in the 1800 block of S. Central Park Ave. Responding officers encountered the suspect, which resulted in a foot chase and an exchange of gunfire at multiple locations in the immediate area. Officers were fired upon by the offender and returned fire, striking the offender. Officers rendered first aid to the offender, who was subsequently pronounced at an area hospital. A weapon was recovered on scene. Officers were taken to an area hospital for observation. The Investigative Response Team is on scene as well as the Civilian Office of Police Accountability. The investigation is ongoing.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department.

The Officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a minimum period of 30 days. This matter remains under investigation and all further inquiries can be directed to the Civilian Office of Police Accountability at (312) 746-3609.
