### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 41-Year-Old Male



**Offender:** Octavio Garcia, 48  
2600 block of S. Komensky Ave  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – February 4, 2026

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on February 2, 2026, in the 2600 block of S. Komensky Ave. He was identified as the offender who, on November 27, 2025, stabbed and seriously injured a 41-year-old male victim in the 2800 block of S. Kedvale Ave. (10<sup>th</sup> District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
