### Offender Charged with Attempt Murder of 55-Year-Old Male



**Offender:** Terry Williams, 63  
2900 block of W. Harrison St.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charge:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Agg Battery / Discharge Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Agg Battery / Use Deadly Weapon  
One (1) felony count – Agg Battery / Great Bodily Harm  
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Robbery -Armed - Discharge Firearm/Bodily Harm

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – March 4, 2026

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on March 2, 2026, at 2:20 p.m., in the 0-100 block of S. Wabash Ave. He was identified as the offender who, on December 20, 2025, at approximately 10:55 p.m., shot and injured a 55-year-old male victim in the 2900 block of W. Roosevelt Rd. (11<sup>th</sup> District). The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
