Juvenile Offender Charged with Vehicular Hijacking & Armed Robbery



Offender: Male, 15

Charges: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed With/Firearm
One (1) felony count – Possess Firearm With/Defaced Serial Number
One (1) misdemeanor count – Criminal Trespass to Vehicle/Physical Control
One (1) misdemeanor count – Possess Ammunition - Without Valid FOID

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on April 3, 2026, at approximately 11:06 p.m., in the 4800 block of W. Armitage Ave. He was identified as one of the offenders who participated, less than 10 minutes earlier, by taking a vehicle and property at gunpoint from a 36-year-old male victim and a 48-year-old male victim in the 5400 block of W. Potomac Ave. (25th District). The offender was quickly placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
