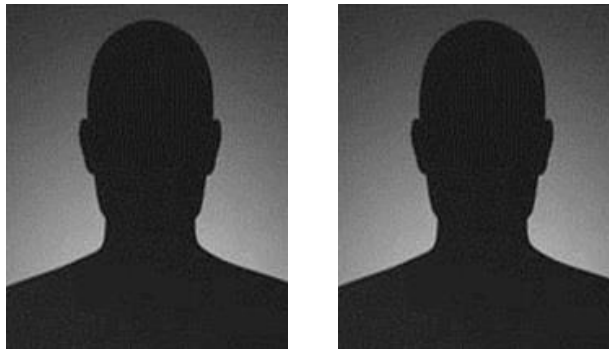

Juvenile Offenders Charged with Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking of a 48-Year-Old Female



Offender #1: Male juvenile, 14

Charges: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm
One (1) felony count – Agg Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Robbery - Armed W/Firearm
Three (3) - Issuances of Warrant

Offender #2: Male juvenile, 14

Charge: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm
Issuance of a Warrant

Narrative: The above offenders were arrested by members of the Citywide Robbery Task Force on February 3, 2026, at 11:11 p.m., in the 1600 block of W. Hubbard St and 1700 block of W. Kinzie St., respectively. They were identified as two of the offenders who, approximately two hours earlier, took a vehicle at gunpoint from a 48-year-old female victim in the 7500 block of S. Emerald Ave. (6th District). The offenders were quickly placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
