Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of Chicago Police Officers



Offender: Sedrick Griffin, 31
2900 block of W. Lake St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Four (4) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Four (4) felony counts – Aggravated Discharge Firearm/Vehicle/PO/Frfrtr
One (1) felony count – Possess Firearm Repeat Felon Offender
One (1) felony count – Felon Possess Weapon
One (1) felony count – Criminal Damage/Govt Prop/<\$500
One (1) misdemeanor count – Driving on Revoked License
One (1) misdemeanor count – Uninsured Motor Vehicle/Bodily Harm
Two (2) traffic citations

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – March 4, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on March 2, 2026, at 6:15 a.m., in the 600 block of W. 76th St. He was identified as the offender who, less than 15 minutes earlier, discharged a firearm in the direction of Chicago Police officers in the 7500 block of S. Peoria (7th District). No one was struck by gunfire, and officers did not return fire. The offender then entered a vehicle and fled the scene. Officers began pursuing the offender, who crashed into parked vehicles in the 7600 block of S. Union. The offender then attempted to flee on foot. He was taken into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
