Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of Cook County Fugitive Task Force Member



Offender: Antwan Ford, 27
1100 block of S. Seely Ave
Ford Heights, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - Strong Probability of Death/Injury
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Peace Officer
One (1) felony count – Leave Scene of Accident - Injury/Death
Two (2) Issuances of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – December 5, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on December 3, 2025, at 9:29 a.m., in the 900 block of N. Lakeview Pkwy. in Vernon Hills, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who, on December 2, 2025, at approximately at 1:27 p.m., struck and seriously injured a member of the Cook County Fugitive Task Force with his vehicle as the task force attempted to apprehend him in the 2500 block of E. 74th St. (3rd District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
