Juvenile Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies, Including Seven Counts of Attempted Murder of Juvenile Victims



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

Charges: Seven (7) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Seven (7) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
Seven (7) felony counts – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - Vehicle/School
One (1) felony count – Aggravated UPW/Person/Loaded/No FCCA
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members on February 4, 2026, in the 800 block of E. 57th St. He was identified as the offender who, on November 21, 2025, discharged a firearm, striking seven victims (a 13-year-old female, 14-year-old female, two 14-year-old males, 15-year-old male, 16-year-old male and 17-year-old male), in the 100 block of N. State St. (1st District). The offender is also charged with the November 21, 2025 armed robbery of a 38-year-old male that occurred approximately 90 minutes later in the 600 block of E. 102nd St. (5th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
