### Offender Charged with Attempt Murder, and Aggravated Battery of 35-Year-Old Male



**Offender:** James Hill, 40  
3900 block of W. Van Buren St.  
Bellwood, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/ Discharge Firearm

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 6, 2025

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on May 4, 2025, at 7:57 a.m., in the 3800 block of W. 14th St., in Chicago, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who approximately 6 minutes earlier shot and injured a 35-year-old male in the 3800 block of W. 14th St., (10<sup>th</sup> District). Due to the swift action of responding units the offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
