Offender Charged with July 2024 Attempted Murder of 51-Year-Old Male

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery - Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery -Discharge Firearm -Occupied Vehicle

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – February 6, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by the Fugitive Apprehension Task Force on February 5, 2025 in the 12300 block of S. Normal Ave. He was identified as an offender who discharged a firearm, injuring a 51-year-old male, who was inside of a vehicle on July 5, 2024 in the 12300 block of S. Normal Ave (5th District).
