Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of a Chicago Police Officer

- Offender:** Darren Brewster, 35
11400 block of S. Davol St., Chicago, Illinois
- Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Two (2) felony counts – Home Invasion/Firearm
Two (2) felony counts – Aggr Discharge Firearm - Occupied Bldg
One (1) felony count – Agg Upw/Pers/Loaded/Fcca/Foid
- Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – December 9, 2025
- Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on December 7, 2025, at 1:22 a.m., in the 11400 block of S. Davol. He was identified as the offender who, less than 30 minutes earlier, unlawfully entered a residence in the 11400 block of S. Davol (22nd District) while armed with a loaded firearm. The offender later became involved in a physical altercation with an 18-year-old male. Responding officers attempted to de-escalate the altercation, at which time the offender's weapon discharged, striking both the victim and a Chicago Police officer in the chest area of his protective vest. A second officer then returned fire, striking the offender. The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
