Juvenile Offender Charged with Aggravated Battery of Four Victims



Offender: Male juvenile, 13

Charges: Four (4) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – UUW - Unlawful Possess Firearm <18
One (1) felony count – Firearm/FOID Invalid/Not Eligible

Court: Juvenile Detention Hearing – 1100 S. Hamilton – June 8, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on June 6, 2026, at 9:56 p.m. in the 4600 block of S. Calumet Ave. He was identified as the offender who, approximately 20 minutes earlier, shot and injured four victims, an 11-year-old male, two 13-year-old males and a 14-year-old male, in the 4500 block of S. Prairie Ave. (2nd District). The offender was quickly placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
