Offender Charged with August 2024 Attempted Murder of 46-Year-Old Female



Offender: Salvador Lopez, 38
3600 block of S. Marshfield Ave.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed W/ Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Unlawful Restraint

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 10, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on April 8, 2025, in the 3600 block of S. Marshfield Ave. He was identified as the offender who, on August 29, 2024, shot and critically injured a 46-year-old female, in the 3700 block of S. Hermitage Ave. (9th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
