Second Juvenile Offender Charged with Multiple Counts of Murder, Attempted Murder in February 2024 Triple Homicide



Offender: Male juvenile, 16

Charges: Three (3) felony counts – Murder - First Degree
Three (3) felony counts – Murder - Other Forcible Felony
Three (3) felony counts – Murder - Strong Probability Death/Injure
One (1) felony count – Attempt – Murder – First Degree
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on July 8, 2026, at 8:49 a.m., in the 6700 block of S. Loomis Blvd. He was identified as the second offender who participated in the fatal shooting of a 14-year-old male, a 20-year-old male and a 36-year-old male on February 25, 2024, at approximately 7:33 p.m., in the 8000 block of S. Vincennes (6th District). A 16-year-old male was also shot and injured. The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
