Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies Including Two Counts of Aggravated Battery of Chicago Police Officers

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – November 10, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on November 7, 2025, at 4:03 p.m., in the 4800 block of W. Chicago Ave. He was identified as the offender who, moments earlier, stole an ambulance. The offender, while in the stolen ambulance, was subsequently involved in a traffic accident, striking two Chicago Police vehicles. During this incident, an officer discharged their firearm in the direction of the offender. No individuals were struck by gunfire. The offender continued to flee, striking multiple vehicles on the roadway and a marked Chicago Police vehicle. The offender was quickly placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
