### **Preliminary Statement of Police-Involved Shooting in the 0-100 block of W. 111th Pl.**

**CHICAGO** - On Thursday, October 9, 2025, at approximately 1:45 p.m., in the 0-100 block of W. 111th Pl., uniformed Chicago Police Department officers attempted to conduct an investigatory stop on a male subject in relation to a recent pattern of robberies. The male subject fled and officers pursued on foot. Officers observed the subject armed with a handgun and gave multiple verbal commands to drop the weapon, which were disregarded. An officer then discharged their firearm, striking the offender in the leg.

Officers immediately rendered first aid to the offender who was subsequently transported to an area hospital and initially reported in serious condition. Two officers also were taken to an area hospital for observation. Two firearms were recovered on scene.

The Investigative Response Team is on the scene investigating.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department.

The Officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a minimum period of 30 days. This matter remains under investigation, and all further inquiries can be directed to the Civilian Office of Police Accountability at [\(312\) 746-3609](tel:3127463609).
