Offender Charged with Attempted Murder and Multiple Felony Counts



Offender: Doniece Bell, 25
6900 block of S. Oakley Ave.

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Public Place
One (1) felony count – Burglary
Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – February 10, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on February 7, 2026, in the 9200 block of S. Burnside Ave. She was identified as the offender who, less than 30 minutes earlier, with a knife stabbed and seriously injured a 34-year-old female victim in the 300 block of E. 95th St. (6th District). The offender was promptly placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
