Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - Second Degree Murder

One (1) felony count – Aggravated DUI/Accident/ Bodily Harm One (1) misdemeanor count – Driving Under Influence of Alcohol

One (1) misdemeanor count - Reckless Driving

One (1) misdemeanor count – DUI Any Amount of Drug
One (1) misdemeanor count – DUI Intoxicating Compound

One (1) misdemeanor count – DUI/ Alcohol/Intoxication Compound/Drug One (1) misdemeanor count – Uninsured - Motor Vehicle/Bodily Harm
