Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of Chicago Police Officer



Offender: Jose Ruiz-Crespin, 22 – 300 block of S. Wilke Rd., Arlington Heights, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - Second Degree Murder
One (1) felony count – Aggravated DUI/Accident/ Bodily Harm
One (1) misdemeanor count – Driving Under Influence of Alcohol
One (1) misdemeanor count – Reckless Driving
One (1) misdemeanor count – DUI Any Amount of Drug
One (1) misdemeanor count – DUI Intoxicating Compound
One (1) misdemeanor count – DUI/ Alcohol/Intoxication Compound/Drug
One (1) misdemeanor count – Uninsured - Motor Vehicle/Bodily Harm

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – March 11, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on March 9, 2025, at 12:08 a.m., in the 100 block of N. Lamon Ave. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, struck and injured a Chicago Police Officer while driving recklessly and under the influence in the 100 block of N.
