Juvenile Offender Charged with Multiple Counts of Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking & Armed Robbery



Offender: Male juvenile, 14

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm
Two (2) felony counts – Robbery- Armed with Firearm
Issuance of Warrant

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force, in conjunction with the Robbery Task Force, on December 10, 2024, in the 500 block of W. Dresser Rd. in DeKalb, Illinois. He was identified as one of the offenders who participated in multiple vehicular hijackings and robberies. The incidents occurred in the following locations earlier this year:

- June 29 in the 3700 block of N. Clark St. (19th District); 44-year-old male victim
- June 30 in the 5100 block of W. Dakin St. (16th District); 36-year-old female victim
- June 30 in the 5200 block of W. Fullerton Ave. (25th District); 38-year-old male victim

The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
