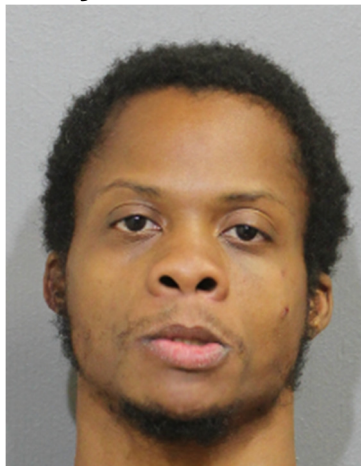

### Offender Charged with Two Counts of Attempt Murder of a 38-year-old male and a 70-year-old female



**Offender:** Trevon Wilson, 31  
1600 block of E. 84th St.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - Strong Probability of Death  
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Battery - Use Deadly Weapon

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – November 12, 2025

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on November 10, 2025, at 4:55 p.m., in the 1600 block of E. 84th St. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, stabbed and injured a 38-year-old male and a 70-year-old female in the 1600 block of E. 84th St. (4th District). The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
