### Offender Charged with Attempt Murder of 23-Year-Old Male



**Offender:** Nicholas Killingsworth, 23  
6000 block of S. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count - Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – September 11, 2025

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on September 10, 2025, at approximately 1:08 p.m., in the 600 block of Oglesby Ave., in Calumet City, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who, on August 20, 2025, at approximately 4:40 p.m., shot and injured a 23-year-old male in the 6000 block of S. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. (3<sup>rd</sup> District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
