Juvenile Offender Charged with Robbery and Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking In Connection to 2023 & 2024 Incidents



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

- Charges: Two (2) felony counts Robbery Armed with Firearm One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Weapon Two (2) misdemeanor counts – Aggravated Assault/Use Deadly Weapon
- **Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on March 11, 2025, in the 1100 block of S. Hamilton Ave. He was identified as an offender who participated in taking a vehicle at gunpoint from a 65-year-old male victim in the 2200 block of W. Diversey Ave. (14th District) on June 24, 2023. The offender also was identified as a participant who took property at gunpoint from two victims, a 50-year-old male and a 50-year-old female, on April 20, 2024, in the 7100 block of S. Green St. (7th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
