Juvenile Offenders Charged with Multiple Felonies, Including Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking, Armed Robbery & Aggravated Battery







Offender #1: Male juvenile, 15

Charges: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm

One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Victim 60+

Offender #2: Female juvenile, 15

Charges: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm

One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Victim 60+

Offender #3: Male juvenile, 16

Charges: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm

One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Victim 60+

One (1) felony count – UUW - Weapon - Possess/Carry/Conceal Weapon

Narrative: The above offenders were arrested by members of the Vehicular Hijacking Task Force on June 12, 2025, at 9:56 p.m. in the 500 block of E. 107th St. (Offenders #2 and #3), and at 10:01 p.m. in the 10700 block of S. Vernon (Offender #1). They were identified as the offenders who, less than an hour earlier, battered a 72-year-old male and took his vehicle and other personal belongings at gunpoint in the 5400 block of S. Calumet (2nd District). The offenders were quickly located, placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
