### Juvenile Offenders Charged with Multiple Felonies, Including Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking, Armed Robbery & Aggravated Battery



**Offender #1: Male juvenile, 15**

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Victim 60+

**Offender #2: Female juvenile, 15**

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Victim 60+

**Offender #3: Male juvenile, 16**

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Victim 60+  
One (1) felony count – UUC - Weapon - Possess/Carry/Conceal Weapon

**Narrative:** The above offenders were arrested by members of the Vehicular Hijacking Task Force on June 12, 2025, at 9:56 p.m. in the 500 block of E. 107<sup>th</sup> St. (Offenders #2 and #3), and at 10:01 p.m. in the 10700 block of S. Vernon (Offender #1). They were identified as the offenders who, less than an hour earlier, battered a 72-year-old male and took his vehicle and other personal belongings at gunpoint in the 5400 block of S. Calumet (2<sup>nd</sup> District). The offenders were quickly located, placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
