Juvenile Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies



Offender: Male juvenile, 15

Charges: One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Robbery - Arm with Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Assault/Discharge Firearm
Four (4) felony counts – Unlawful Vehicular Invasion

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Citywide Robbery Task Force on March 12, 2026, in the 1500 block of S. Kedvale Ave. He was identified as an offender who participated in multiple robbery-related incidents by reaching into the victims' vehicles and taking or attempting to take property. In one incident, the offender discharged a firearm, but no one was struck. All of the incidents occurred earlier this year:

- February 18, 2026 in the 1500 block of S. Keeler (10th District); 19-year-old male victim
- February 26, 2026 in the 1000 block of N. Leamington (15th District); 24-year-old male victim
- March 11, 2026 in the 1500 block of S. Keeler (10th District); 27-year-old male and 27-year-old female victims

The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
