Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of Chicago Police Officers



Offender: Cordero Ramey, 26
8300 block of S. Buffalo
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – UUW - Weapon - Felon Possess Weapon/2nd+
One (1) felony count – Poss Firearm Repeat Fel Offend
One (1) felony count – Mfg/Del 15<100 Gr Heroin/Angl
Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 14, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on May 11, 2026, at 10:39 p.m. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, exchanged gunfire with Chicago Police officers who were attempting to conduct an investigatory stop in the 3100 block of E. 83rd St. (4th District). The offender was struck about the body and officers immediately rendered aid. No officers were injured. The offender was placed into custody, at which time a weapon and suspected narcotics were recovered. The offender was subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
