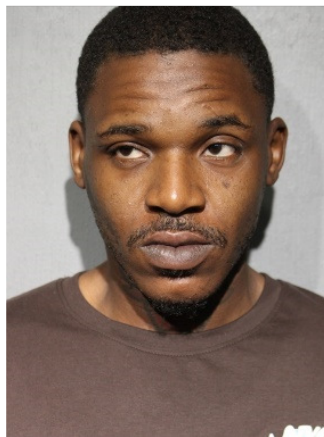

Offender Charged with Reckless Homicide of 25-Year-Old Male and Serious Injury of 37-Year-Old Male



Offender: Daron Lipscomb, 31
3600 block of W. 63rd St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) Felony Count – Reckless Homicide/Motor Vehicle
One (1) Felony Count – Failure Report Accident/Death
One (1) Felony Count – Failure Report Accident/Injury
Two (2) Felony Counts – IVC - Leave Scene of Accident - Injury/Death

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – July 15, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on July 13, 2026, in the 3000 block of W. 63rd St. He was identified as the offender who, on February 20, 2026, was driving in the 3500 block of N. Elston Ave. (17th District) when he struck another vehicle, causing the death of a 25-year-old male and serious injury of a 37-year-old male. The offender fled the scene following the crash. The offender was later placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.

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
