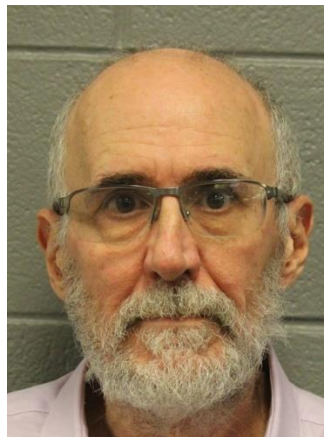

Offender Charged with December 2004 Murder of 40-Year-Old Male



Offender: David Barklow, 68
400 block of N. Lake Shore Dr.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree
One (1) Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – November 15, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on November 14, 2025, in the 10000 block of O'Hare. He was identified as the offender who fatally shot a 40-year-old male on December 18, 2004, in the 1100 block of N. Dearborn (18th District). This investigation involved partnership with the Cook County State's Attorney's Office, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), the DOJ's Office of International Affairs, the FBI, the U.S. Marshals Service, the U.S. State Department, the Regional Security Office at the U.S. Embassy in Lima, Peru, Peruvian authorities and INTERPOL. The offender was located in Peru, extradited to Chicago and subsequently charged accordingly.
