### Juvenile Offenders Charged with Attempted Murder of 18-Year-Old Male



**Offender #1:** Male juvenile, 16

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon

**Offender #2:** Male juvenile, 13

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon

**Narrative:** The above offenders were arrested by the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on January 14, 2025, in the 4100 block of W. Wilcox St. They were identified as two of the offenders who participated in stabbing an 18-year-old male, causing critical injuries, on November 14, 2024, in the 0-100 block N. Western Ave. (12<sup>th</sup> District). The offenders were placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
