Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies, Including Attempted Murder of 24-Year-Old Female



Offender: Michael Jenkins, 19
1800 block of S. Harding Ave., Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Three (3) felony counts – Robbery - Armed with Firearm
Two (2) felony counts – Receive/Possess/Sell Stolen Vehicle
One (1) felony count – Aggravated UPW/Person/<21
One (1) felony count – Identity Theft/<\$300

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – July 16, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Robbery Task Force on July 14, 2025, in the 3700 block of S. Princeton. He was identified as one of the offenders who, on July 13, 2025, shot and seriously injured a 24-year-old female, before robbing the victim and a second 24-year-old female at gunpoint in the 400 block of W. Wellington (19th District) The offender is also charged with the June 9, 2025 armed robbery of a 21-year-old female in the 700 block of W. Roscoe (19th District), as well as in connection to vehicles reported stolen on June 9, 2025 from the 3100 block of N. Broadway (19th District) and on July 12, 2025 from the 600 block of W. Wellington (19th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
