Offender Charged with Attempt Murder of 26-Year-Old Male



Offender: Alejandro Tellez, 36
1000 block of N. Knollwood Dr.
Schaumburg, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 16, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on May 14, 2026, at 9:20 p.m., in the 100 block of N. La Salle St. He was identified as the offender who, moments earlier, stabbed and seriously injured a 26-year-old male victim in the 100 block of N. State St (1st District). The offender was quickly placed in custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
