Offender Charged with Attempted Murders of Chicago Police Officer & 63-Year-Old Female



Offender: Treavor Taylor, 26
11300 block of S. Indiana Ave.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Three (3) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Peace Officer
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Government Employee
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - PO/Firefighter

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – March 17, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on March 14, 2026, at 11:35 p.m., in the 11100 block of S. Corliss Ave. He was identified as the offender who, approximately 20 minutes earlier, shot and injured an on-duty Chicago Police Sergeant in the 11200 block of S. Corliss Ave. (5th District). The offender is also charged with the attempted murder of a 63-year-old female victim, who was shot minutes earlier in the 11300 block of S. Indiana Ave. (5th District). The offender was quickly placed into custody and was subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
