### Juvenile Offenders Charged with Multiple Felony Counts of Burglary



**Offender #1: Male juvenile, 16**

**Charges:** Three (3) felony counts – Burglary  
One (1) felony count – Criminal Trespass to Vehicle/Physical Control

**Offender #2: Male juvenile, 17**

**Charges:** Three (3) felony counts – Burglary  
One (1) felony count – Criminal Trespass to Vehicle/Physical Control

**Narrative:** The above offenders were arrested by members of the Auto Crimes Task Force in conjunction with the Area 3 Mission Team on April 17, 2026, at 9:10 a.m., in the 7800 block of S. Cornell Ave. They were identified as offenders who, several hours earlier participated in multiple burglaries and a criminal trespass to vehicle listed below.

- Burglary at 3:25 A.M., 3500 block of W. Fullerton Ave. **(14<sup>th</sup> District)**
- Burglary at 4:24 A.M., 2500 block N. Halsted St. **(19<sup>th</sup> District)**
- Trespass to vehicle at 5:00 A.M., 1900 block of W. 47th St. **(9<sup>th</sup> District)**
- Burglary at 5:30 A.M., 3600 block of W. 26th St. **(10<sup>th</sup> District)**
