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Preliminary Statement of Police-Involved Shooting in the 5600 block of S. Michigan Ave.

CHICAGO - On Tuesday, November 18, 2025, at approximately 11:50 a.m., in the 5600 block of S. Michigan Ave., uniformed Chicago Police Department officers attempted to conduct an investigatory stop on a male subject who was believed to be in possession of a firearm. The male subject fled and officers pursued on foot. One officer observed the subject armed with a handgun and gave multiple verbal commands, which were disregarded. An officer then discharged their firearm, striking the offender. The offender sustained a graze wound to the abdomen and the right arm.

Officers immediately rendered first aid to the offender who was subsequently transported to the University of Chicago hospital and initially reported in good condition. The officer was taken to an area hospital for observation. One firearm was recovered on scene.

The Investigative Response Team is on the scene investigating.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department.

The Officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a minimum period of 30 days. This matter remains under investigation, and all further inquiries can be directed to the Civilian Office of Police Accountability at [\(312\) 746-3609](tel:3127463609).

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
