Juvenile Offender Charged with September 2024 Attempted Murder of 15-Year-Old Male



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/ Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – UUW - Weapon - Machine Gun/Automatic Weapon
One (1) felony count – UUW Unlawful Possess Handgun
One (1) felony count – Receive/Possess/Sell Stolen Vehicle

Court: Juvenile Detention Hearing – 1100 S. Hamilton – February 20, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on February 19, 2025, in the 2600 block of W. 94th St. in Evergreen Park, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who shot and seriously injured a 15-year-old male on September 22, 2024 in the 5700 block of S. Wolcott Ave (7th District). The offender was also in possession of a stolen vehicle taken on September 21, 2024 from the 3000 block of W. 77th St (8th District). The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
