Offender Charged with Aggravated Kidnapping

Charges: One (1) felony count – Aggravated Kidnapping/<13 Intel Disabl
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Kidnapping - Inflict Harm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Child<13/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count – Domestic Battery - Aggravated
One (1) felony count – Child Abduction/Father Conceals
One (1) misdemeanor count – Domestic Battery/Bodily Harm
One (1) misdemeanor count – Violate Order of Protection

Court: Detention Hearing – 555 W. Harrison – April 21, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on April 18, 2025, at 12:44 p.m., in the 1000 block of W. Glenlake Ave. He was identified as the offender who, approximately 20 minutes earlier, battered an 18-year-old female, then kidnapped and battered a 1-month-old female in the 1100 block of W. Granville Ave. (24th District). The offender was quickly placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.

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
