Offender Charged with Multiple Felony Counts, Including Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery & Aggravated Assault



Offender: Daniel Aguirre, 42
4600 block of N. Springfield Ave.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Three (3) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - Strong Probability Death/Injure
Two (2) felony count – Aggr Discharge Firearm - Po/Fireman
Two (2) felony counts – Agg Battery/Use Deadly Weapon
Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Unlawful Restraint
One (1) felony count – Agg Assault Peace Off/Fire/Er Wrk
One (1) felony count – Aggr Discharge Firearm - Occupied Bldg

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – July 22, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on July 20, 2026, at 1:14 p.m., in the 4600 block of N. Springfield. He was identified as the offender who, just over two hours earlier, shot and critically injured a 67-year-old female in the 4600 block of N. Springfield (17th District). The offender then held two individuals, a 14-year-old female and a 42-year-old female, at gunpoint inside the residence. SWAT was called to the scene, and a SWAT officer was shot after responding to the incident. The armed offender was taken into custody a short time later and was subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.

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
