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CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES COMMAND STAFF PROMOTIONS

CHICAGO — Chicago Police Department (CPD) Superintendent Larry Snelling today announced three new promotions within the Administration and Standards Division, the Bureau of Patrol and the Bureau of Detectives.

Commander Evelynna Quarterman has been promoted to Deputy Chief of the Administration and Standards Division. Within the Bureau of Patrol, Captain Sheamus Mannion will be promoted to Commander of the 1st (Central) District. Lieutenant James Labbe has been promoted to Commander of the Area 3 Detective Division.

"These highly qualified leaders were elevated to their new positions because of their strong commitment to safeguarding all Chicagoans, holding offenders accountable and supporting the victims of crime," said Superintendent Larry Snelling. "Deputy Chief Quarterman, Commander Mannion and Commander Labbe are mentors within our department and trusted law enforcement professionals in our communities."

Deputy Chief of the Administration and Standards Division – Evelynna Quarterman

Commander Quarterman, a 32-year member of the Department, most recently oversaw the Inspection Division as its Commander. As Deputy Chief, she will oversee the Inspection Division, the Court Section, the Traffic Court Unit and the Administrative Support Section. She was previously a Lieutenant in the Area 4 Detective Division Violent Crimes Section and the Commander of the 3rd (Grand Crossing) District. As a Lieutenant, she worked in the 2nd (Wentworth) District and 7th (Englewood) District as a Watch Operations Lieutenant and Field Lieutenant. Deputy Chief Quarterman worked as a Sergeant in the 2nd District, serving as the Accountability Sergeant and School Resource Sergeant. She was also a Sector Sergeant, District Gang Sergeant and Tactical Sergeant in the 11th (Harrison) District. She also worked in the Area 2 Detective Division for more than a decade as a Watch Coordinator. Deputy Chief Quarterman holds a Master of Jurisprudence from DePaul University College of Law and a bachelor's degree in African American Studies and Political Science from Roosevelt University. She also attended the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command.

Commander of the 1st (Central) District – Sheamus Mannion

Commander Mannion, a 25-year member of the Department, most recently served as the Captain and Executive Officer of the 1st (Central) District, which he will now lead. He brings years of experience within the district to this role. As the Executive Officer, he oversaw daily operations and planned for large-scale events and First Amendment assemblies in the 1st District. Commander



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Mannion also previously served as the Captain and Executive Officer of the 15th (Austin) District. As a Lieutenant, he was assigned to the Office of the First Deputy Superintendent as the Commanding Officer of Detached Services and as an Administrative Lieutenant. Prior to this, he was a Watch Operations Lieutenant in the 10th (Ogden) District. As a Sergeant, he worked within the Gang Investigation Division and supervised personnel assigned to ATF operational teams and the Cook County Jail Liaison Team. He first worked in the 1st District as a Tactical Sergeant before becoming the Business Liaison Sergeant. As a Sergeant, he also worked in the Targeted Response Unit, the Bureau of Professional Standards and the 10th District. Commander Mannion holds both a master's degree in Educational Administration and Foundations and a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice Sciences from Illinois State University.

Commander of the Area 3 Detective Division – James Labbe

Commander Labbe, a 24-year member of the Department, will oversee the Area 3 Detective Division where he has most recently served as a Lieutenant. As a Lieutenant, he was responsible for the investigation of property crimes within the area and he worked to address crime patterns within Area 3. Prior to this, he was assigned to the 7th (Englewood) as a Lieutenant, where he was also assigned as a Sergeant. Commander Labbe first worked in the Bureau of Detectives in the Area 5 Detective Division. As a Detective, he investigated hundreds of violent crimes and property crimes. Additionally, Commander Labbe has been an active member of the U.S. Coast Guard Reserve since 2013 and previously served as a U.S. Army reservist for eight years. Commander Labbe holds both a Master of Public Administration and a bachelor's degree in Law Enforcement Management from Calumet College of St. Joseph. He also attended the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command.

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
