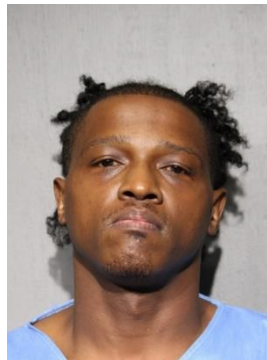

Offender Charged with Murder of 40-Year-Old Female



Offender: Demar King, 35
500 block of S. 155th Pl
Calumet City, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Fleeing/Damage > \$300 Prop
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Fleeing/Police/21 MPH
One (1) misdemeanor count – Leaving the Scene
One (1) misdemeanor count – Fail to Give Info/Render Aid/Prop
One (1) misdemeanor count – Speeding 35+ MPH over limit
One (1) misdemeanor count – Resisting/Obstruct/Peace Officer/Corrections
Various traffic citations

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – October 21, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department Area One Homicide Investigation Support Team and the Illinois State Police on October 18, 2025, at 3:01 p.m. in the 2000 block of S. Union Ave. He was identified as the offender who, several hours earlier, shot and killed a 40-year-old female in the 5400 block of S. Shields Ave. (9th District). Officers later located the offender driving in traffic and requested assistance from Illinois State Police. The offender attempted to flee before being taken into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
