Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 26-Year-Old Female, Domestic Battery, and Home Invasion



Offender: Vincent Zuniga, 35
7200 block of S. Harding Ave
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Home Invasion/Cause Injury
One (1) felony count – Domestic Battery - Aggravated
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed - Other Dangerous Weapon
One (1) felony count – Burglary - Residential

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 23, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on April 21, 2026, in the 5700 block of W. Fullerton Ave. He was identified as the offender who, on April 16, 2026, stabbed and seriously injured a 26-year-old female victim during the commission of a home invasion in the 5400 block of W. Ohio St. (15th District). The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.

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
