### Offender Charged with Multiple Felonies, Including Two Counts of Attempt Murder of Chicago Police Department Officers



- Offender:** Maurice Reddick, 34  
7800 block of S. Winchester Ave., Chicago, Illinois
- Charges:** Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
Two (2) felony counts – Agg Assault Peace Off/Fire/Er Wrk  
One (1) felony count – Aggr Discharge Firearm - Occupied Bldg  
Three (3) felony counts – Poss Firearm Repeat Fel Offen  
Three (3) felony counts – UYW - Weapon - Felon Posses Weapon/2nd+  
One (1) felony count – Armed Violence/Category I  
One (1) felony count – Pcs - Possess 15<100 Grams Cocaine  
One (1) felony count - Pcs - Possession - Poss Amt Con Sub Except (A)(D)  
Issuance of Warrant
- Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 22, 2026
- Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on May 19, 2026, at 9:25 p.m., in the 8600 block of S. Marquette Ave. He was identified as the offender who, less than an hour earlier, discharged a firearm in the direction of two on-duty Chicago Police Department officers in the 8600 block of S. Marquette Ave. (4<sup>th</sup> District). The offender is also charged with discharging a firearm at a 33-year-old female victim in the same location. No one was struck by gunfire, and no injuries were reported. The offender was quickly placed into custody and was subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
