Offender Charged with Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery of 43-Year-Old Male



Offender: Rey Gonzalez, 21

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/ Use Deadly Weapon
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/ Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count – Mob Action/Violence

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 22, 2025

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on May 21, 2025, in the 3100 block of W. Harrison St. He was identified as the offender who battered, stabbed, and seriously injured a 43-year-old male in the 2800 block of S. Kedzie Ave on May 3, 2025. (10th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
