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### **Preliminary Statement on Police-Involved Shooting in the 11000 block of S. Millard Ave.**

**CHICAGO** – On Thursday, January 23, 2025, at approximately 3:49 p.m., Chicago Police Officers assigned to the 22nd (Morgan Park) District responded to a person with a gun call at a residence in the 11000 block of S. Millard Avenue. Upon arrival, officers observed a male individual leaning out of a window. Officers attempted to de-escalate the individual and provided direction for him to keep his hands visible. During the encounter, an officer discharged his weapon, striking the individual. Officers located the individual on the ground and rendered medical attention.

The male individual was taken to an area hospital in serious condition. The officer was taken to an area hospital for observation. Investigative Response Team is currently on-scene investigating.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department.

The Officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a minimum period of 30 days. This matter remains under investigation and all further inquiries can be directed to the Civilian Office of Police Accountability at (312) 746-3609.

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
