### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 36-Year-Old Female & 49-Year-Old Female



**Offender:** Nicholas Young, 31  
1600 block of S. Ridgeway Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two (2) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – July 25, 2025

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on July 23, 2025, in the 100 block of W. Jefferson St. in Joliet, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who, on June 3, 2025, shot and injured two victims, a 36-year-old female and a 49-year-old female, in the 4100 block of W. 19<sup>th</sup> St. (10<sup>th</sup> District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
