Offender Charged with Murder of 23-Year-Old Male, Attempted Murder of 25-Year-Old Male



Offender: Martez Walls, 21
0-100 block of E. 100th St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – Receive/Posses/Sell Stolen Vehicle
Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – March 24, 2026

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Fugitive Apprehension Unit on March 23, 2026, in the 3000 block of Curry Ln. in Green Bay, Wisconsin. He was identified as the offender who, on January 7, 2026, fatally shot a 23-year-old male and seriously injured a 25-year-old male in the 0-100 block of E. 100th St. (5th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.

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
