### Offender Charged with Leaving the Scene of Fatal Traffic Crash



**Offender:** Iryna Kalach, 39  
2300 block of W. Grand Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Leave Scene of Accident - Injury/Death  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Failure to Give Information/Render Aid/Inj  
One (1) citation – Operate Uninsured Motor Vehicle  
One (1) citation – Fail to Exercise Due Care  
One (1) citation – Failure to Yield to Pedestrian

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 25, 2025

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on April 24, 2025, in the 1700 block of S. State. She was identified as the offender who, on January 24, 2025, was driving in the 700 block of N. Oakley Blvd. (12<sup>th</sup> District) and fatally struck a 66-year-old female pedestrian. The offender fled the scene without reporting the incident or rendering aid. The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
